## GUEST RULES FOR CABIN RENTALS

### Sveadal enforces the following policies:

1. Positively, no pets are allowed in rental units. You will be refused admittance if you bring a pet.
2. No firearms, B-B guns, or fireworks are permitted in Sveadal.
3. Motor scooters, mini-bikes, or other gasoline powered cycles are prohibited. All bike riders under the age of 18 must wear proper headgear.
4. Please report to a manager any maintenance problems in your rental.
5. You are responsible for the actions and behaviors of your family and guests.
6. We reserve the right to refuse future reservations to anyone who does not abide by our policies.
7. Dishes and flatware are provided. Bring your own linens, (sleeping bags are easiest) blankets, towels.
8. You are required to bag and tie your garbage in appropriate garbage bags. Please dispose of your garbage in the red garbage building located near the mail boxes on Croy Road. Recycling containers also located there.
9. Check-out times vary depending if the cabin is to be rented immediately after your departure. Check with the host of your event for the exact time.
10. The cabins do not have any form of central heating and can be cold in the winter! If you anticipate cold weather, please bring extra blankets and/or a warmer sleeping bag.
11. You are obligated to wash and put away all dishes and pans, empty the refrigerator, remove all garbage, and follow the posted list for check-out. See item #6.
12. Should you wish to do laundry, bring quarters and soap for the washer and dryer located behind the clubhouse.
13. There are absolutely no open fires in Sveadal! If you wish to barbecue, please use only "standard" briquettes (NO Match-Light, etc) and the electric starter found in each cabin.

Telephone service: The telephone at the rear of the clubhouse has restricted service and will allow only 911 and local calls. A calling card or credit card is required for toll or long-distance calls. Guests with dial-up internet service can plug into the extra telephone jack provided. Cell service is spotty and the best reception seems to be on the Basketball court.
