

Common Questions About Renting in Sveadal

How can I find out if there are any cabins available to rent in Sveadal?

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What are the cabins like...what do they have in them?

Summertime in Sveadal means outdoor living! Cabins do not have sofas and chairs, but are designed primarily for eating and sleeping. Each cabin has a combination of three beds, most double, and some cabins have a queen size bed along with one or two doubles or another double and single. Each bed has pillows, a mattress pad and a bedspread. Most cabins have one small bedroom, bathroom, and combined kitchen area and sleeping room.

The apartments are four units adjoined by pass through doors, which make them ideal for family and friends to rent. The doors can certainly be locked if access is not wanted between the front and back units. The apartments do not have a bedroom, but do have a dressing area, near the bathroom for a degree of privacy.

All cabins and apartment bathrooms have sink and a shower, and a full kitchen with microwave oven and toaster. Basic necessities (dishes, flatware, pots and pans, utensils) to prepare meals are provided. There is a Weber BBQ kettle on each deck, along with a Picnic Table for outdoor eating. There is coin operated washer and dryer behind the clubhouse. Cabins do not have T.V's, phones or internet access. This is old fashioned fun!

What can we do in Sveadal?

Your cabin or apartment rental fees include use of the pool and facilities. Sveadal has a swimming pool and a baby pool. The pool typically has a lifeguard present. There is a snack shack, bathrooms and ping-pong table at the pool. There are two tennis courts, used on a first come first served basis. Sveadal has playground equipment, as well as a full outdoor basketball court. Rolling lawns are great to play Frisbee or have a picnic on. There are trails for hiking and a county park up the road. Creek walking in our lovely creeks is always fun with lucky ones catching a crawfish or two. Sveadal hosts a Bingo night, game night, and Wednesday night dinner in the Clubhouse during the summer weeks. Night swim on Friday nights with S'mores at the horseshoe pit complete the weeks activities.

What is nearby.... Shopping or other activities?

The town of Morgan Hill is just 15 minutes away, and has all of the grocery and other basic shopping one can need. There is a Trader Joes, as well as almost every other market or drug/retail store, restaurants and fast food. Morgan Hill has a bowling alley and movie theatre. The Outlets in Gilroy are just 15 minutes away, as are a number of wineries for wine tasting. Santa Cruz can be reached in just an hour; golf courses are also nearby.

Do I have to clean the cabin when we leave?

In addition to the lease fee for the week, a nominal fee of \$50 is charged for cabin cleaning. Renters are asked to leave the kitchen and refrigerator clean, empty the trash, and put the beds together. A cleaning service will do the bathrooms, and floors.
